Harvest time is upon us and changes are in store! As many of you know, the fall season is a time of growth in today's church. By now, all of the vacations have ended, the kids are back to school, and people's lives are finally starting to get back into a more steady routine.

With that being said, we have and will continue to see the attendance in our morning services grow. There have been numerous studies that showed once a Church has reached 80% of its' capacity, something needs to happen. We have seen some of this happen here at Orange Hills. There have been people who have called us on Monday and said that the parking lots were full, or there were no seats for their family to sit together. This is a problem! It's a good problem, but it's one that needs to be addressed. So, what is the answer? According to the study, there are a few possibilities. They can expand their current facility, move into a larger facility, or change their service times to create space and accommodate the growth. We have chosen to change our service times. Beginning on Sunday, October 12, we will be changing our service times to 9 AM and 10:30 AM. Our Hymn-song service at 6 PM will remain the same.

In addition to the time change, we will also see a change in style in the 9 AM service. This service will have a more modern approach to worship. From the music, to the atmosphere, to the message, we will be taking a more "out of the box" approach. In implementing this change, we believe that we will be able to better reach the young couples, and the 40 and under age group. We have already had a very positive response from our young families and they are very excited about the new service and plan on inviting friends and family.

We have also had questions about Sunday School. Those that attend the 9 AM service will have classes available to them during the 10:30 AM service. The adult study taught by the Massingills will continue as it is now at 9 AM. We will have Children's programs available in both services.

We know that anytime our schedules and routines are changed that it can be inconvenient, but we believe that this is God's plan for Orange Hills. If we can all make a few small sacrifices and we stay faithful in our Church attendance, we will see and experience more of the rich blessings of God.
